

ShockWatch Indicators

Visual method to encourage safe handling during shipment and help detect concealed shipping damage.

Rough handling during transit and subsequent door damage is a leading cause of project completion delays and added replacement costs. In an effort to help identify and reduce freight damage issues, Oshkosh Door Company is affixing a ShockWatch indicator to each pallet of doors that is shipped via an LTL or common carrier. Oshkosh will start affixing the ShockWatch sticker to pallets on 2.5.09.

The ShockWatch indicator (shown on left) is meant to encourage safe handling of pallets as well as minimize concealed damage to your shipments.

The indicator is activated each time the pallet receives a shock that may cause door damage. When activated a red liquid is released into the clear tube in the middle of the sticker. This becomes a permanent record of rough handling.

If a pallet is delivered to a job site or your location and you notice the device activated, it is highly recommended that you note the fact on the bill of lading and inspect the doors prior to signing the bill of lading.
